

The Great Pumpkin Smash 2022

We were completely blown away by the warm reception to our second annual "most fun way to compost" event. It never got old watching pumpkins sail majestically to their doom after being fed into the Jack-o-Launcher trebuchet. The smash boards and Gourd-o-tine were so popular we had to literally dig them out several times during the afternoon to keep them in use!

- 2,000 people in attendance
- 30,000 pounds of pumpkins diverted from the waste stream
- 25 metric tons of Co2 kept out of the atmosphere (that's more than one American produces in an entire year!)
- 72 bunches of carrots illicitly harvested (IYKYK)
- 480 apple cider donuts consumed









Our volunteers were total rockstars. Did you know that the ENTIRE lacrosse team from Endicott showed up in force? Plus many other Endicott students as well as core Green Beverly folks. From running the Pumpkin Destruction Zone to painting faces to bringing ice to vendors to making coffee to sorting waste, these are the people who made the Pumpkin Smash such a smashing success. We see you, and we're grateful for you! If you want a cool hat too, make sure to volunteer with us for next year's event.

Green Beverly's website manager, Simone Wagner, made this amazing video of the Smash and set it to music she recorded on site played by the Splinters. Thanks, Simone!

Speaking of waste sorting, Beverly's fab Waste Reduction Committee was on the scene, keeping the event as low-waste as possible. They collected **80 gallons of compost, 55 gallons of recyclables, 45 gallons of returnables**, and merely 15 gallons of trash! Let's work together to get to zero next time.
